NOTE

Property Owner:

It is important that you understand your responsibilities as defined on this permit application;

Two things CAN be omitted from your contract with the pool dealer, and these items then become your responsibility. They are:

1. Electrical Work: You must obtain a permit from the Inspection Bureau, Inc., 222 E. Central Pkwy., 381-6080, for this work, AND you must see that such work is done by an electrician or by yourself (if qualified). Also, there are certain inspections that must be made during the construction, and there is a final inspection. Consult the Inspection Bureau for specific information on these inspections.

THE POOL CANNOT BE USED SAFELY UNTIL ALL OF THIS IS DONE.

2. Fencing: The pool area must be fenced in, or access denied in accordance with the City of Harrison Zoning Code, BEFORE the pool is filled. See Code reference below.

SECTION 701. SWIMMING POOLS

701.1 PRIVATE SWIMMING POOLS: A private swimming pool, not including farm ponds, shall be any pool, lake or open tank not located within a completely enclosed building and containing or normally capable of containing water to a depth at any point greater than one and one-half (1½) feet. No such swimming pool, exclusive of portable swimming pools with a diameter less than twelve (12) feet or with an area of less than one hundred (100) square feet, shall be allowed in any "B," "RC" or "R" District except as an accessory use unless it complies with the following conditions and requirements.

- (a) The pool is intended and is to be used solely for the enjoyment of the occupants of the principal use of the property on which it is located.
- (b) It may not be located, including any walks or paved areas or accessory structures adjacent thereto, closer than ten (10) feet to any property line of the property on which located.
- (c) The swimming pool, or the entire property on which it is located, shall be so walled or fenced so as to prevent uncontrolled access by any person from the street or from adjacent properties. Said fence or wall to be not less than four (4) feet in height and maintained in good condition, with a gate and lock. (See Board of zoning appeals meeting of April 8, 1975.)

If you sign Section 4 of this application, YOU must comply with all of the Electrical requirements.

YOU are responsible for complying with Section 5 of this application.
